LEED is an internationally recognized certification program for green building design, construction, operations and maintenance solutions. The LEED framework and rating system was developed by the U.S. Green Building Council (USGBC) in 2000.



According to the USGBC website, LEED-certified buildings are designed to:

- Lower operating costs and increase asset value
- Reduce waste sent to landfills
- Conserve energy and water
- Be healthier and safer for occupants
- Reduce harmful greenhouse gas emissions
- Qualify for tax rebates, zoning allowances and other incentives in hundreds of cities
- Demonstrate leadership, innovation, environmental stewardship and social responsibility.
