No charge for "basic" recycling collection!

Santa Clara businesses (*commercially zoned parcels*) are encouraged to participate in our collection programs for mixed recyclable materials.

- There is no charge for "basic" weekly service of one 96-gallon recycling cart.
- Collection will begin December 1, 2010.
- Higher levels of recycling collection are also available.

Mixed recycling now includes:

PAPER PRODUCTS

- corrugated cardboard & paper boxes
large or multiple pieces should be flattened and/or cut
- shredded paper
in a paper bag, secured with a staple
- aseptic boxes
juice, soup & soy milk
- hard cover books
up to 40 lbs.

GLASS BOTTLES & JARS

ALUMINUM & METAL

- aerosol cans (*empty*)
- scrap pieces up to 40 lbs.

PLASTICS LABELED ♻️

- plastic bags
Protect the environment by avoiding single-use bags. Reuse them when possible. When recycling multiple bags, stuff one bag full of the others; tie off the full bag before placing in the recycling.
