# 5 Ways To Save!

- 1. Have Mission Trail come and do a waste audit.
- 2. Buy recyclables and avoid Styrofoam, Mylar and hazardous material.
- 3. Ask customers to use their own bags and reuse them.
- 4. Collect bottles and cans.
- 5. Get the wet waste out of the recycling and trash.



# **3 Bin System**

### Create a 3 bin system inside the office to assist employees and customers to help separate trash, recycling and organic waste.

#### Inside your business:

- 1. Purchase a small black garbage receptacle for Mylar, Styrofoam and other contaminates that are not recyclable.
- 2. Purchase a blue receptacle for all recyclable cans, bottles, paper, cardboard, and metals
- 3. Purchase a green receptacle or compost bin for food scraps and wet organic material

### **Cardboard Reminders**

Flatten and/or cut your boxes to make as much room as possible in your Recycle bin. Place shredded paper inside a paper bag to prevent flyaways.

#### Have extra recycle?

Cut and bundle your extra cardboard down to a size that will fit directly inside the recycle bin. The driver will not reload the bin with cardboard that will not fit back in the bin.



### Did You Know?

Recycling one ton of cardboard:

- Saves 390 kWh of energy
- Saves 1.1 barrels (46 gallons) of oil
- Saves 6.6 million Btu's of energy
