AB341

MANDATORY COMMERCIAL RECYCLING REQUIRE-

MENTS. A business (includes public entities) that generates four cubic yards or more of commercial solid waste per week or is a multifamily residential dwelling of five units or more shall arrange for recycling services. Businesses can take one or any combination of the following in order to reuse, recycle, compost or otherwise divert solid waste from disposal:



- Self-haul.
- Subscribe to a hauler(s).
- Arrange for the pickup of recyclable materials through Mission Trail Waste Systems.

Subscribe to a recycling service that may include mixed waste processing that yields diversion results comparable to source separation.

AB1826

This Assembly Bill requires business generating 4 cubic yards of trash per week create an organic waste recycling program, including multifamily residential dwellings consisting of five or more units. Organic waste means food waste, green waste, landscape and pruning waste, nonhazardous wood waste, and food waste.

Cardboard Reminders

Flatten and/or cut your boxes to make as much room as possible in your Recycle bin. Place shredded paper inside a paper bag to prevent flyaways.

Have extra recycle?

Cut and bundle your extra cardboard down to a size that will fit directly inside the recycle bin. The driver will not reload the bin with cardboard that will not fit back in the bin.

Please Keep All Commercial Trash and Recycling Enclosures Clean

All too often, trash and recycling enclosure are found with large amounts of debris on the ground and creates an unsafe and difficult service situation for our valued drivers. Trash and recycling bins can weigh up to 700 Lbs. Debris found on the floor can get stuck in the bins wheels and create such a slippery surface where it is nearly impossible for a driver to move the bin. Please make sure the enclosure areas are kept clean and free of ground debris so our drivers can safely service all of the Los Altos commercial businesses.
