### Stop & Think

What goes where? Sorting properly is critical to keeping recyclable or compostable material out of the landfill. Organic materials should go in the green compost bin, while clean dry cardboard, paper, glass, metal, and plastics should go in the blue recycling. ### Break it Down

Optimize space in your blue bin and keep recyclables clean and dry. Break down all cardboard boxes and do what you can to save space in your blue bin to ensure it's not overflowing.



### Keep Lids Closed

Do your part to keep drivers safe and eliminate litter. Trash should be secured in clear bags to prevent materials from blowing onto the street. Make sure all trash fits inside your bin with the lid tightly closed.
