Please keep all wet food scraps or organic material out of your blue recycle bin.

Believe it or not, until recently the United States and a handful of other countries were shipping a majority of their recycling off to China for processing. As of January 1, 2019 China has changed their handling policies and contamination rates for all acceptable recycling material. We need your help to ensure the material your business is generating is clean, dry and placed in the proper Mission Trail waste bin. This will assist MTWS in capturing the best material for recycling diversion.

CHECK LIST - To improve all recycling loads

- ✓ Is your company capturing Mylar (coffee bags) & Styrofoam (packing materials)? Please discard these materials in the black bin.
- ✓ Does your business have a 3- bin collection system (Black, Blue & Green)?
 - Please call Mission Trail Waste Systems at 650- 473-1400 and speak to one of our recycling specialists.

Best recycling practices

- If your business is generating coffee grounds and wet organic material (food scraps, employee lunches & yard clippings), please place these materials in the green organic container.
- Please advise employees all recycling material should be dry and clean before discarding in your blue container.
- All cans, glass, plastic bottles, paper and cardboard is to be placed in your blue recycle bin.
- Please continue to visit missiontrail.com for continued education and outreach materials.

If all Los Altos businesses adopt these best practices, our recycling material will be cleaner, free of contaminates and easily repurposed.

Effective January 1, 2019, Assembly Bill (AB) 1884 bans full-service restaurants from providing single-use plastic straws, unless requested by the customer. The first and second violations result in a "notice of violation." Subsequent violations are punishable with a \$25.00 fine for each day of violation (not to exceed \$300.00 annually).
