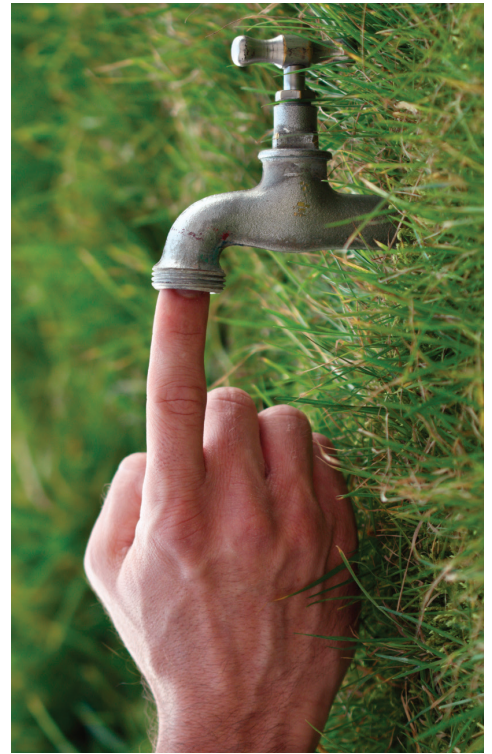

Be green like a pro, by conserving H²O!

We can all do our part to continue to monitor and evaluate our water usage. Take and implement a few of the tips below to help conserve our precious resource:

- ✓ Compare water usage reports from the prior year and understand water usage benchmarks for your business.
- ✓ Install low flow and water efficient fixtures in restrooms and kitchens
- ✓ Replace old sprinklers with low flow drip lines and dial back watering to no more than two days a week
- ✓ Limit garbage disposal use by using a strainer to collect food scraps and discarded restaurant waste
- ✓ Audit results and make your employees part of the process.



Recycling is easy as one, two and three

Give your staff the opportunity to do the right thing. If you find your company is recycling large quantities of cardboard, plastics or glass – make sure you have a dedicated recycling bin to discard this material. Use an organics bin to capture food scraps and landscape trimmings, and the trash bin for all other material.



In the office, use clear bags and provide your staff to do the right thing by:

1. Use a blue bin for paper, glass, cardboard, aluminum, and plastics
2. A green bin for clean food scraps and food solid paper
3. A black bin for everything else
