# Reduce Waste This Holiday Season It's the Season to be Green!

CalRecycle estimates that between Thanksgiving and New Years, more than 1 million tons of additional waste are generated each week nationwide. Fortunately, there are a number of simple steps that can be taken to help minimize holiday waste and keep what remains out of the landfill.

#### Here are 10 things you can do:

- $\checkmark$  Send electronic greeting cards.
- Encourage the use of durable, reusable shopping bags.
- Promote the use of reusable or recyclable gift wrapping. Avoid foil and plastic wrapping.
- Purchase/sell items packaged in materials that are easy to reuse, recycle or compost.
- Purchase/sell gifts that create little or no waste (*gift cards, concert tickets, and potted plants for example*).
- ☑ Purchase/sell rechargeable batteries.



#### Thank Customers for Shopping Locally

People who shop locally do more than support Los Altos businesses—they help the environment. Pollution and packaging are both reduced by shrinking driving distances and omitting shipping.

- ✓ Invest in a potted or artificial Christmas tree. If a fresh-cut tree is a must, be sure to put it out by your garbage/recycling bins during the first two weeks after Christmas. Mission Trail will collect if for composting. Note that the stand, lights and decorations must be removed.
- Use durable, energy efficient LED holiday lights.
- Serve food and beverages, including takeout, in reusable, recyclable, or compostable containers.
- Donate untouched holiday party leftovers to the local food bank (*visit* www.shfb.org for information). Compost the food scraps that cannot be donated.
