- Put in new batteries and recycle the old ones.

Collection Day Check List

- Place carts out for collection by 6:00 a.m.
- Make sure cart wheels are facing your home.
- Make sure cart lids are fully closed.
- Leave three feet between carts.
- Avoid placing carts near other obstacles; i.e. mailboxes, cars, trees with over hanging branches.

Friendly Reminder:

Store carts out of sight and off the street as soon as possible after service. The City of Los Altos Municipal Code requires containers to be removed from the curb within 24 hours of collection. This is intended to enhance neighborhood appearance.

Care For Your Cart

Regular cart maintenance is important.

- Wipe down and/or rinse your cart every few weeks. Take care to use only as much water as necessary and to drain over a landscaped area. Scoop up and bag or box residue before placing in the appropriate cart.
