- AlertSCC – County: 408-808-7871 • AlertSCC – City of Los Altos: 650-947-2800
- Prepare for bad air quality due to smoke, and for potential evacuations
- Store N-95 masks for your family's use for smoky air
- Prepare a "Go Bag" for family members and pets in case you need to leave quickly, see www.losaltosca.gov/gobag
