Be Mindful of Holiday Waste



1. **SHOP LOCALLY** and seek out businesses that use recyclables and less packaging.
2. **REUSE, REDUCE, AND REPURPOSE** last year's gift bags, wrapping paper, bows, kids' art or pictures to creatively wrap gifts for family & friends.
3. **REDUCE FOOD WASTE** by buying enough to feed the family but avoids excessive leftovers. When in doubt, keep the wet waste out of the dry waste.
4. **CREATE LIMITED WASTE** parties by:
 - Using reusable utensils, cloth napkins, tablecloths and dishes, if you don't have enough of them, there is no shame in borrowing them or having guests bring a few to use.
 - Avoid balloons, streamers and Mylar decorations. Use plants, fabrics and other decorative items to brighten the party.
 - Reuse holiday and place setting cards from the previous year.
5. **UNDERSTAND SB 1383** (Organic waste reduction).
 - www.calrecycle.ca.gov/organics/slcp/education
 - Controls waste into our landfills and creates more reusable products from compostable material and food scraps.
6. **FLOCKED CHRISTMAS TREES** will be collected, however, please be mindful when flocking your trees as they are not compostable and will be put in the landfill.

SB 1383

Starting in 2022, all jurisdictions will need to provide organic waste collection services to all residence and businesses and recycle these organic materials using recycling facilities such as:

- Anaerobic digestion facilities that create biofuel and electricity
- Composting facilities that make soil amendments

REMINDER: Please place all food scraps, yard clippings and food soiled paper in your organics bin.

Mission Trail Waste Systems will collect Holiday trees on your regular service day beginning December 27th through January 14th.

Please Follow These Easy Tree Collection Guidelines:

- 1. Remove the tree stand and all decorations.**
- 2. Cut tall trees into pieces no longer than five feet.**
- 3. Place next to your carts prior to 7am on your service day.**

PLEASE NOTE: Flocked trees will be collected but cannot be composted.
