ZERO WASTE

What is “zero waste”? To some, it means reducing the amount of waste sent to landfills. Others may see zero waste as an opportunity to repurpose & reuse generated materials from their homes or workplaces. And others may see zero waste as a way to push back & ask manufacturers to redesign products to be less wasteful, less toxic, and easier to recycle. Zero waste is a choice, process, and philosophy, requiring effort to make smart choices about products that can be reused & recycled without causing harmful downstream effects.

A Zero Waste goal, according to the California Integrated Waste Management Board, requires “maximizing our existing recycling and reuse efforts, while working to ensure that products are designed for the environment and have the potential to be repaired, reused, or recycled”. If we all make a concerted effort to view our landfills as the last resort, zero waste becomes much more achievable.

Ideas to Help Your Business Continue to Strive for Zero Waste

- “Right-size” your bins to ensure that you can recycle and compost as much as possible.
- Consider locking your bins to avoid contamination and keep space available for sorted materials.
- Maintain separate recycling and compost containers inside your business, to make it easier for staff and customers to sort materials.
